




Financial Hardship Has Changed Over Time in Westchester County



The Household Survival Budget reflects the minimum cost to live and work in the modern economy and includes housing,
child care, food, transportation, health care, a smartphone plan, and taxes. It does not include savings for emergencies or
future goals like college or retirement. In 2021, household costs in every county in New York were well above the Federal
Poverty Level of 215 280 for a single about on 455,500 for a family of four.
